SUB-CONTRACT DRIVER CODE OF CONDUCT

Driver and Vehicle Presentation

- Vehicles must be maintained in a clean and good condition and free from contaminants
- Driver's appearance must be clean and presentable at all times.

Road Laws

Drivers must comply with all road laws and be considerate of others by:

- Being professional at all times
- Being fit for duty – alert, healthy and prepared for the driving task
- Observing speed limits and seat belt laws
- Observing fatigue regulations
- Observing drug and alcohol laws
- Leaving a safe travelling distance between themselves and other vehicles
- Travelling in left lanes unless overtaking
- Avoiding the use of noisy engine brakes at inappropriate times
- Obeying all other applicable laws.

Driver distraction is a risk and to reduce this risk drivers shall:

- Avoid the use of mobile phones, two-way radios and other forms of communication whilst the vehicle is moving
- Fully prepare for any journey to avoid being distracted when driving.

Forrest Logistics Sites

- All drivers must comply with all site procedures, policies and signage while on Forrest sites, including the Forrest Logistics Fitness for Work Policy.

Forrest Logistics' Customers' Sites

- Drivers must comply with all customer site-specific procedures, policies and requirements. This includes any drug and alcohol testing processes, which may include testing at random, post-incident and in response to suspected impairment
- Drivers shall be polite and courteous to customers and their employees and not engage in any verbal or physical altercation, but refer any issues back to the relevant Forrest Logistics co-ordinator.
